Learning to explore faith in healthy ways is central to The Feast. To help young people do this we ask everyone to commit to these simple guidelines.

- **listen** to what everyone has to say
- **be honest** in what we say
- **speak positively** of my own faith, rather than negatively about other people's
 - **respect other people's views**, even if I disagree
 - **not treat people here as a spokesperson** for their faith
 - **not tell others what they believe**, but will let them tell me
- acknowledge **similarities** and **differences** between our faiths
 - **not judge people here** by what some people of their faith do
 - **not force people** to agree with my views
 - **make every effort to get along with everyone** regardless of their faith, gender, race or age

At any stage we can ask for a discussion to be stopped if we feel uncomfortable.
