- Short-term partnerships and collaborations

- Lack of integration of FBOs in the national/local government disaster planning process

Recommendations

Increase dialogue among and within communities along with disaster preparedness trainings

Establish and develop information sharing system to understand each other's expectations and objectives

■ Shift sector – based cluster system to area- based flexible approach when coordinating disaster response

Recommendations...Cont..

Make the UN and country pooled funds more streamlined, available and accessible to FBOs

Develop and implement a common, streamlined partnership framework across UN agencies

Engage in pre-disaster technical collaborations to accompany faith groups

Recommendations...Cont...

Invite/integrate FBOs in to national dialogues and networks (predisaster and during responses).

Develop community-level emergency communication plans

Required resources for effective partnerships

- Long-term collaboration and partnerships to response in real quick time during the emergency situations
- Pool of expertise
- Annual gathering of donors and implementing agencies with similar vision and objectives
- Trained facilitators as well as trained community members especially, CBOs and community leaders
- Forum for international and local FBOs
